



Fire and Emergency Procedures

COURSE AIMS

This course is intended to provide a delegate with the underpinning knowledge and skill required to deal with fires in the workplace by means of portable fire fighting equipment and to assist in the evacuation of premises.

- Be aware of the importance of raising the alarm promptly and contact procedures for the emergency services
- Have a clear understanding of the need to provide ready access and comprehensible information to the emergency services in the event of an emergency.
